

Parties in Belgrave Square Garden

The agreed objectives for Belgrave Square Garden state that in providing amenities for authorised users no one activity should dominate another. Parties should therefore not dominate the garden and prevent other garden users from enjoying the space. Please bear this in mind when planning your event.

Children's Parties

Children's parties may be held as follows:

- Grosvenor Landscape Management (GLM) must be notified at least 21 days in advance. Please send your request to glm.office@grosvenor.com who will review your proposal and check availability. If approved, the payment option will be made available. You will receive a booking confirmation on completion of payment.
- Numbers must be limited to 20 children. A party is deemed to be a gathering of 10 or more (children and adults).
- Parties may not be hosted for a child over 8 years of age.
- Children must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian – at least 1 adult for every 3 children.
- No marquees may be erected without prior arrangement with Grosvenor.
- No bouncy castles may be erected.
- No ball games or games that may damage the garden are allowed.
- The garden must be cleared of all litter caused by the party.
- No barbeques are allowed.
- No music is permitted.
- A party charge of £250 will apply to those keyholders who do not reside on Belgrave Square. GLM may engage a security guard to oversee the party.

Other Parties

For the leaseholders and freeholders of properties on Belgrave Square, please contact glm.office@grosvenor.com if you are looking to host a small event in the garden.

Whilst garden members are permitted to bring guests into the garden from time to time, this must be reasonable, Grosvenor reserve the right to ask large gatherings to leave the garden. Grosvenor consider a gathering is a group of 8 or more.

Additional Information

- The organiser must be a garden member and be present. The organiser will be held responsible for any cost that Grosvenor may incur from damage to the garden, additional cleaning and attendance or labour costs.
- Grosvenor holds Public Liability insurance. However, it should be noted that this does not extend to provide any indemnity to the event organiser.
- Grosvenor have the discretion to terminate membership and access to the garden if they consider the user has either not followed the garden rules or has used the garden which prevents other users from enjoying the space.
